Moving Forward Under (New) Restrictions



As you are well aware, the government of Saskatchewan has announced that places of worship across the province will be restricted to thirty participants as of Friday, April 16. Our Bishop – while strongly protesting the injustice of this move to target families and churches – has instructed the Diocese to comply with this restriction. This means St. Paul’s must re-implement the protocols for registration and attendance.

Current registrations will be closed, and reopened with the new limit of thirty (30) people. This means even if you were registered before, you must re-register.

Registration is now required for Daily Mass. In order to facilitate sanitizing, **confessions will be moved back to the previous schedule of: Monday - Saturday from 11:00 - 11:45 am** Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the Rosary are suspended until further notice.

We thank God for the gift of being able to celebrate the Easter feasts with some measure of increased openness. We ask for your continued prayers, first and foremost, in this difficult time. This has come with such short notice that we greatly appreciate your understanding as we make last-minute adjustments.
