A Church in Synod

"The Lord moves in mysterious ways" – a favourite saying of a friend.

This Sunday our parish lifts its eyes from the burdens of COVID and looks beyond to the service of one another and of the marginalized entrusted to us.

There is a familiar rhythm from autumns past –

How is the Lord calling me to special **Stewardship** of my service in the life of St. Paul's? How is the Lord calling me to share my stewarded resources in the **Bishop's Annual Appeal?**

These questions flow from Jesus' Words in today's Gospel,

"For the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve,

and to give his life a ransom for many." (Mk 10:45)

Jesus' way is first of all the way of service,

"whoever wishes to be first among you must be slave of all" (Mk 10:44)

Jesus' way is the way we are asked to follow this Stewardship Sunday.



There is also a slightly different note this Sunday – it sounds from Rome, from our Holy Father Francis.

It is the call to a world-wide Church **SYNOD** to consider how we can be a "Synodal Church".

SYNOD – the word tells a story of how a people can live together:

Greek synodos 'meeting',

from syn-'together' + hodos 'way'.

A SYNODAL CHURCH is a Church that follows the JESUS "the WAY" together.

Pope Francis has called the universal Church to attend to three dimensions of those who "meet together on the Way":

Communion, Participation, and Mission.

Bishop Mark has written,

"Communion and Mission describe the mystery of the Church, while Communion expresses the very nature of the Church. In this, Pope Francis builds on the teaching of recent popes. Saint Paul VI stated that, "... communion, that is, cohesion and interior fullness, in grace, truth and collaboration... and mission, that is, apostolic commitment to the world of today." Saint John Paul II stressed that *koinonia* gives rise to the Church's mission of serving as a sign of the human family's intimate union with God.

This will follow a course of listening in the power of the Holy Spirit.

It will follow a two-year process – beginning with the diocesan phase initiated by Bishop Mark this Sunday at Holy Mass at the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit.
