***“Everyone deserted me, but the Lord stood by me and gave me strength,
so that through me the proclamation might be completed
and all the Gentiles might hear it.”*** (2Tm 4:8)

Ours seem like unfavourable times.

Inflation, changing weather, wars, plague, and secularism.

Should we not batten down the hatches and take care of ourselves?

400-years-ago it was worse.

The Thirty-Years war was at the half-way point of butchering a third of Europe's peoples.

Plague, License, Ravaging, and Doubt.

Yet in 1622, Holy Church established the *Congregation for the Propagation of the Faith*.

Christ did not establish a *fortress Church* but a *forward Church*

ever pressing the gates of hell which crumble before it.

We are a Church of proclamation (as St. Paul tells us) longing that

“all the Gentiles, all people might hear the message:

***“if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord
and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead,
you will be saved.”*** (Rm. 10:9)

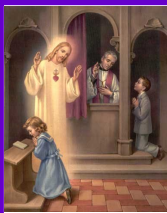
