Happy Mother's Day!

The priests of our diocese just completed a beautiful retreat in Muenster.
I was very conscious of your prayers for me and for my brothers. Thank you.

Our retreat master, Msgr. Hector Vila, Bishop of Whitehorse invited us
with his Peruvian passion to again lift our eyes and see that

“Christ is crazy in love with you!”

Reconnecting with the concrete experience of this utter love that Baptism opened for us,
the Bishop called us to witness to Jesus: **“To be a Christian, you must see a Christian”.**

It was a challenging call to “take back our priesthood”

reminding us of the words of Mother Teresa to a priest:

“Unless you pray for three our more hours a day, you put in jeopardy your priesthood”.

He called us to give real things to our families – and for me this means my parish!

– and to be ready to die for them.

A call to leave behind mediocrity – “the catechesis of the Devil” –

and live instead from the Good News that

“God loves you! Jesus is the Kyrios, the Lord of life and death!”

Whew – this message was so weighty that I was reduced to silence –

and silence is the gift of the Monastery in Muenster.

In the silence the “Advocate ...
the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive” (Jn. 14:16)

And in the Silence May's gift of a Mother: Mary, Queen of Priests.
Mother of those who are no longer orphans –

“I am coming to you.” (Jn. 14:18)

Woman who received the same Spirit that

“abides with you, and he will be in you” (Jn. 14:17)

Mother who bore the Christ, whom I and you now bear,

“I am in my Father, and you are in me and I in you” (Jn. 14:20)

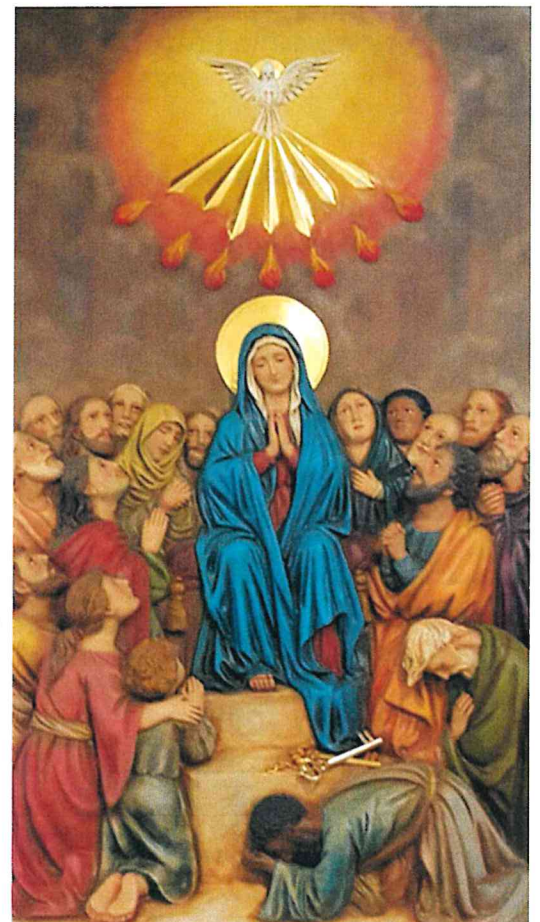
Mother of obedient loving who always says
