Annual General Meeting of the Roman Catholic Parish of St. Paul's Co-Cathedral

Sunday, November 19, 2023— at 11:15

In 1934, an Act of the Saskatchewan Legislature incorporated the Roman Catholic Parishes and Missions in the Diocese of Saskatoon. This means that legally St. Paul's Parish is its own Corporation. Bishop Mark has been leading the Diocese to explicitly realize this structure as it also is the preferred way of organization of the Universal Church. The Members of this Corporation are by statute, the Bishop (President), one official of the diocesan curia, the Pastor (Vice-President), and two parishioners to be nominated and selected by the Bishop (usually the chairpersons of the Parish and Finance Councils). This requires that our Parish continue its practice of having an AGM with the additional legal implications that it be the setting for the public meeting of the Corporation.

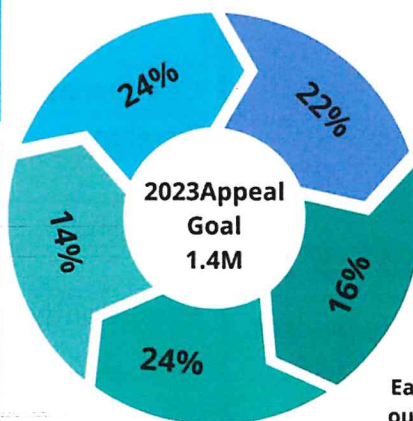
