

3rd Sunday of Lent March 3, 2024

The Foolishness of the Cross and the Father's House



Fasting clears from our lines of sight the thick underbrush that hides from us the Tree of Life - the Cross.

So entangled are we by busyness, being busybodies, and boredom that it is hard to look up and see, shining above us, flooding within us, and illuminating what rests before us.

Jesus' call this Sunday comes from the Cross with brilliant clarity: "Take these things out of here! Stop making my Father's House a marketplace." (Jn. 2:16) Our lives, our loves, our work, our play, are all to be the "Father's House" -and not a place where we sell our souls to whatever merchant of consumption promises pleasure.

The Cross turns over all these tables that sin against the inestimable beauty that is ours as the "Father's House." The price of clearing away the underbrush and marketing stalls? The Cross. There Jesus Christ – our God and Saviour – pays the price of renovation.

One tear in His Flesh enough to clear away all the thick tangle of our sins. One drop of His Blood enough to sweep away the tables where we sell our birthrights to buy bitterness.

But it is not just one tear in His Flesh – it is Jesus' whole Body the hangs on the Cross.

It is not just one drop of His Blood – it is a never-ending flood pouring from His Side.

And it never ends this Foolish Love of God.

For over and over again the Spirit of the Risen Christ brings us to this Eternal Cross.

How? Most supremely in the Holy Eucharist.

The never-ending Blood-Love that in a flood of dying love overturns the tables and remakes us the Father's House. The never-ending Body-Love that fills every place of the House making us Temples of the Spirit.

How is it possible to take this so for granted that we fit this Eucharist into our schedules or fret over what rituals feel best? It is possible. Because this earthquake of love that shakes the world from the Cross at the Eucharist just crushes human strength and understanding ... for it is of God. "Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God." (1 Cor. 1:24)

So, we fast from control.

We fast from noise and distraction.

We allow Jesus to cleanse us, the Father's House.

We worship in love at the Eucharist of the Foolishness of the Cross.
