# 10<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

## June 9, 2024

It was wonderful to go for our family walk last Sunday carrying the Blessed Sacrament down Spadina on our beautiful river. It was a particular joy to be led on our walk by the First Communicants who were carrying the Lord whom they had received into the world.

Italians love going on a “*passeggiata*” – a leisurely stroll in the cool of the evening. Walking is so good for us, we know that our bodies were made for walking and running and not so very much for sitting. I loved going for long walks with my professors and Spiritual Directors – it always felt that our conversations were made more rich by doing that which Adam and Eve were able to do in Eden – walk with God.



Then they fell, and decided that they didn't need God and could walk like gods. And so they started walking all over each other, treading destructively on the good earth, and headstrong and pride-full setting their own paths and goals.

And so, paths divided. Each of us like sheep going his own way. Now we rarely walk together. When we do go out it is for a run on our own or with our heads plugged into our own music or podcast. Strange way to journey we whose bodies and spirits have been made to journey with others, with God, in God, amidst God's creation.

That is why it was so lovely to walk with the Blessed Sacrament – with Jesus. Because Jesus is God-returning-to-walk-with-us. Self-exiled from the Garden of Eden, the Garden of Paradise comes to us in our exile to lead us home. How? Because the Garden is the Heart of Jesus – a Garden-house filled all the open places of the Father's house and welcoming each of us in our particular journey to join in the great Journey deeper and deeper into Love.

Do we see that when we walk from Holy Mass we are living monstrances with “*an eternal weight of glory beyond all measure?*” (2 Cor. 4:16) We are bearing Christ into the streets. We are walking together as



Adam and Eve first did in Eden. We step on the heads of the serpent and crush Beelzebul and his divisiveness as our heads are held high. We know that it is not a solitary lonely wandering down paths we in our pride have to choose for ourselves. We know that we walk already with Jesus in the new Garden-house, “*house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.*” (2 Cor. 5:1)

June is here – Passover become *passeggiata* and we walk with the Lord with a parade that sounds with His footsteps. Or is that the rhythm of His Sacred Heart beating?
