Still in the Storm

Call me foolish. I am going to return to youthful adventures and go canoeing with a group of men of the parish in about a month. The quickest way for a man of a certain age to get hurt is to try an keep up with younger men in a physical activity. But I have warned them— I might end up like Jesus in the boat ... asleep while they row.

There is a peril on Northern Saskatchewan lake: a thunderstorm striking suddenly with such a del-

uge that it is literally impossible to tell up from down in the rain. This also has been a peril on the Sea of Galilee. Blinding, disorienting, dangerous storms... and the disciples are in the middle of it.

Where is Jesus? He is asleep. What might the Holy Spirit be telling us in this story?

There are times in which we are just overwhelmed with what comes pouring down on our heads. It is so easy to be disoriented—not knowing what is up or down. This is not only our experience, it is the experience of the Barque of St. Peter, the Church, throughout history ... and clearly so today. We live in a world where "orientation" is understood in terms of sexual attraction - not about a vision for life. Immediate feelings and desires have



replaced the discipline of living in view of a greater goal. Our Church—which is called to live only for God and His Heavenly Kingdom—has found its Divine mission of compassion distorted into enablement of those caught in the miasma of feelings. The result? Storms, chaos, hopelessness, and anger.

What are we to do?

Wake Christ up! Or better yet ... Wake up to Christ!

How can we find order in our lives or our world when we are asleep to Him, "that even the wind and the sea obey"? (Mark 4:41) If we do not waken ourselves to Him who dwells in us and offers Himself to us through the Sacraments, through prayers, through the witness of the Saints, what else awaits but perishing? That is the lot of far too many of the Baptized. That is the chaos of an unhappy world caught in the storms of Godlessness. Are we asleep to our power in Christ to silence the distress?

Let us WAKE up to the One who commands the chaos, "Be silent! Be still!" (Mark 4:39) lest instead of finding stillness in the storm we remain still disoriented by the storm.

"Why are you afraid? Have you still no faith"? (Mark 4:40)
