“Forgive ... but do not forget”
There is the “but” word that, like all “but” words, undoes the first word.
That “but do not forget” is the only way that the call to forgive seems reasonable.
“Forgive” - so that you can let go of your hurt.
“Don’t forget” - so that you can hold the other forever accountable
Not so fast, says Jesus to us.
If you do not forget, then you have not forgiven.
No, ifs, ands, or buts about it.
To forgive - means to “fore-give” ... to give the other person a future completely free of what they have done to you.

Now, is that possible? Really?
For human persons it is not possible ... but with God all things are possible.

The impossible happens every time we go into the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
The same Lord Jesus who met that adulteress in the dust
The same Lord Jesus who refused to go along with the impartial condemners.

That same Lord Jesus meets us in our mess and sin
That same Lord Jesus speaks through a Church of compassionate sinners
That same Lord Jesus speaks the same words
to you
to me
“neither do I condemn you. Go your way, and from now on do not sin again”

And the “impossible” is now utterly real in God
Our sins are no more.

And we can go in peace ... to sin no more ... to forgive ... and to forget.

So be it.
